

2016 Peterson Vineyard Pinot Noir

Harvest dates: 9-7 and 9-9-16

Fermentation: 100% destemmed

Aging: 16 months in 100% used French oak

Bottling date: 1-4-18

Alcohol: 14.2%

The 2016 Peterson Vineyard Pinot Noir is in its typical soft, fragrant and earthy style, most similar to the 2012 Sandler Peterson. The wine is comprised of clones 667 and Pommard. It always drinks well at a young age, then ends up aging as long as any of the heavier Pinots. Expect the 2016 Peterson to last through 2026.
