The 2019 Sandler Cortada Alta Vineyard Pinot Noir was one of only three wines Sandler produced for the vintage. It was a spectacular harvest with cool weather throughout the summer. This led to a long hang time, and harvest was in the first week of October. If you were fortunate enough to get some of the ultra-low production Pinot Noir, the best drinking window is between 2021 and 2030.
