Amanda Lazare meticulously oversees every aspect of the vineyard, from budbreak through pruning. It is her dedication to growing the best fruit she can that makes this a special place for Cabernet.

The 2016 Lazare Cabernet is similar to the 2015 in its fruit profile, but has less mint in the nose and more acidity on the palate. It may require more time in the cellar than the 2015 did, so the anticipated maturity is between 2019-2028.
